

Homemade modelling clay

Works with all pigments. For children the natural pigments are preferred however these are not the colours they prefer. Take care that the modelling clay is not eaten.

Ingredients/measurement:

- √ 1 glass of flour
- ✓ 1/2 glass of salt
- √ 1/2 glass of bicarbonate of soda
- √ 3 teaspoons of vegetable oil or glycerine
- ✓ 1/2 glass of tepid water
- √ pigments

Preparation:

- 1. Mix the flour, salt and bicarbonate then add the oil, and finally the water progressively and stir to obtain a consistent paste
- 2. Mould by hand and add a little flour if necessary
- 3. Divide into separate part for each pigment used. They can be mixed beforehand with a little water or oil to achieve a consistent colour.

And thus you are ready to create some models, all for a few pounds!

Keep in air-tight containers in the fridge. (Add water or flour later if the modelling clay is too dry or too wet)
